### **What you need to know to achieve compliance with the new Regulations and Survey process**

**Description:** This session will cover how to prepare for the new survey process and the new Phase II requirements. Together we will take a deeper dive into specific requirements that have important changes and new expectations. By using case examples we will work through how to operationalize the new requirements in your facility. We will discuss feedback from providers across the country about their experience with the new survey process and deficiencies they received. Specific topics to be covered include: facility assessment, antibiotic stewardship, infection control plan, how to make the survey visit run smoothly, care plan changes, and emergency preparedness regulations. Sessions will focus on either checking to make sure the facilities material is consistent with the new regulations or if the facility does not have these material yet developed, it will provide them with opportunity to develop a draft set before leaving the workshop.
